MARLBORO WATER DIVISION UPGRADES ROAD/LANE CLOSED – DETOURS IN PLACE – POLICE PRESENT

ROUTE 520 IN THE AREA OF THE MARLBORO MIDDLE SCHOOL - Marlboro Township Water Utility Division will be installing new valves at the intersection of Marlboro Middle School's entrance driveway and Route 520 on **Wednesday June 26, 2019 AND Thursday, June 27** from 7am until work is complete. This work will require a water service interruption / low pressure event at Marlboro Middle School and Marlboro Township Library. All customers affected by the repair work have received notification of this water event. There will be no changes in water quality. Detours will be in place, signs will be posted and Marlboro Police will be on site.

Ryan Road – Milling and paving operations have commenced this week from 7am – 5pm between Robertsville Road and the Manalapan border.
